TEACH, LEARN, QUALITY

WHAT

This course on educational quality focuses on three different aspects:

- The introduction to EFQM as a quality system;
- the methodology of introducing a quality system;
- and the Human Factor, Human Resources and ways to motivate the school team to get involved in quality development.

This approach is quite unique as those 3 aspects are intertwined and interdependent. Without the full participation of all members of the school team, no educational quality can be achieved.

Quality development is a key point in European education. It's one of the priorities of all policy makers and educational authorities in Europe. This international course aims at answering the questions of how to start and develop a quality management plan.

It also offers guidance on how to implement the needed quality awareness. At the same time it focuses on internal strategies to make the quality management plan operational.

The course wants to contribute to the empowerment of schools, training centres and adult education institutions as learning organisations.

The course provides knowledge, methodology, insights and skills needed to achieve this goal. During the course the trainees will be introduced to methods which enable them to edit their own quality system.

WHERE

The course is organized in Portugal, Lisbon Beach (Costa da Caparica) as a residential seminar in a delightful 4 star hotel located at 14 km from the centre of Lisbon on the south bank of the River Tagus (Rio Tejo).

BY WHOM

The course is organised by a consortium of European educational organisations that worked together in the Teach, Learn and Quality project.

The trainers from Flanders (Belgium), Iceland, Finland and Portugal have a broad experience in teaching and learning methods, quality management and change management.

COST AND FUNDING

The total course fee is \in 1300. Portuguese participants, who don't use the hotel accommodation, obtain a reduced fee.

Staff from schools, colleges, any kind of adult education institutions, principals and heads, deputy heads, chiefs of department, coordinators, quality coordinators, middle management, teachers and educators, school inspectors, school counsellors, pedagogical advisors, school phychologists... can apply for funding within the Erasmus+ programme.

Also school inspectors, school counsellors, pedagogical advisors, phychologists... involved in the strategic development of the school or centre for adult education can be part of the funding application of the school or centre for adult education.
